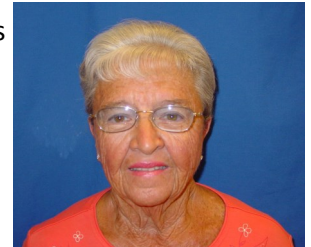
## Featured Volunteer—Brandley House
